The Planet Earth: Sound and Music Production Residency invites emerging and established sound & music practitioners to explore humanity's relationship with the planet through innovative and crafted sounds.

Residents will engage with ecological, social, and philosophical questions about the Earth's future, culminating in a final concert at ARTos House showing the results of the research residency.

### **Residency Goals**

- Foster artistic reflection on environmental awareness and planetary interdependence.
- Support cross-disciplinary creation that merges music and sound arts.
- Encourage innovative storytelling formats that bridge art, science, and culture.

- 1. Motivation Letter (max 1 page): How does your practice relate to "Planet
- 2. **Project Proposal** (max 2 pages): Outline your intended research or production concept.
- 3. Portfolio: 5 recent works.
- 4. CV / Biography (max 2 pages)

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

- Artistic originality and conceptual depth 25%
- Relevance to the theme "Planet Earth" 25%
- Feasibility and clarity of proposal 25%
- Commitment to experimentation and dialogue 25%
